During 2010 to 2017, I worked closely with Pastor Tony Stiff in the Adult Christian Education (ACE) ministry at Centerpoint. Pastor Tony created a dynamic adult education ministry at our church during his years there. Some of his innovations included the establishment of "best practices" training for lay leaders/teachers, a "covenant statement" to which all lay teachers subscribed, and teacher appreciation events. Pastor Tony also created a "core curriculum" that provided adult education offerings in the areas of Bible study, theology, church history, apologetics, missions, spiritual formation and disciplines, and Christian living (e.g., parenting, finances, marriage, etc.) These classes were offered three times a year during the fall, spring, and summer "semesters." Tony's leadership was instrumental in creating a vibrant ACE ministry that continues at Centerpoint to the present.



In addition to working closely with Pastor Tony on the ACE ministry at Centerpoint, I was able to observe his growth as a preacher and leader in the church. He is a gifted preacher who delivers thoughtful, Biblically-based sermons that our congregation found compelling. 



